

Broomfield Xeriscape Demonstration Garden Animal Garden

Xeric Level: 

Irrigation: This garden is irrigated with popup sprinklers

Mulch: The mulch used in this garden is from the City and County of Broomfield's tree recycling program. It is applied to a depth of about 2 inches to curtail weed growth and reduce moisture evaporation. No weed fabric has been used under the mulch in order to promote the spread of the plants and to allow the soil to be amended as the mulch breaks down.

Plants: The xeric plants in this garden all have playful animal names
